

R E S O L U T I O N

- WHEREAS** the Board of Supervisors has decided to implement a dust control program on roads with high traffic volumes and has directed the County Engineer to develop such a program; and
- WHEREAS** calcium chloride (CaCl) will be the dust control product used; and
- WHEREAS** the Board of Supervisors directed the County Engineer to create a program that not only was based on traffic count, but influenced by midsummer traffic patterns; and
- WHEREAS** within this program Tier 1 roads will receive one continuous application and Tier 2 roads will receive one spot application on curves, bridge approaches and intersections except during Spring 2008 where due to budget concerns the Board chooses only to do Tier 1 roads; and
- WHEREAS** the Engineer's discretion will be used to determine Tier 2 locations and Engineer may decide to add or remove roads from Tier 1 and 2 as necessary due to construction projects, rocking program, winter/spring road damage, changes in traffic patterns and other unforeseen issues; and
- WHEREAS** if program alterations made by the Engineer are permanent changes, the Tier 1/Tier 2 list will be amended and approved by the Board of Supervisors in an official Board Meeting;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the list of roads and the rules and regulations pertaining to said dust control program are attached and hereby made a part of this resolution.
