

## **DUST CONTROL PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Application rate: 0.5 gallons per linear foot (38% solution)
- 1 application each year (preferably between mid-May and mid-June)
- County will continue to blade these roads when determined by Engineer or his designee
- Roads which are dead-end or turn into dirt only qualify for Tier 2
- No CaCl applied at intersections with B-level roads on Tier 2
- Based exclusively on Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) traffic counts. No traffic count requests approved.
- If driveway of inhabited home falls partially within an area which receives CaCl in Tier #2, Des Moines County will pay to apply CaCl 150' past drive.
- Additional applications may be purchased from a private contractor, at resident's expense, after the County sponsored CaCl has been applied. A standard dust control permit must be approved for such application.
- The following approximate distances and guidelines will be followed unless Engineer or designee determine a modification is necessary (site by site basis):
  - Tier 2 intersections - 150' from intersection
  - Tier 2 bridges - 150' from both ends
  - End of pavement - 150'
